I am the Pastor at Beardstown First United Methodist Church in Beardstown, IL. I have been in Beardstown since July 2023, when I was appointed there the Bishop.

I was most recently appointed to Jacksonville, IL at Centenary United Methodist Church. My journey has also included pastoral appointments in Bonfield, Minonk, Wenona, Lostant and Richland along the way. My ministry began in Roanoke, IL where an Emmaus Weekend filled me with the spirit and I felt called to ministry. Before that, I was a newspaper publisher, the owner of a small offset printing and bindery business and also owned multiple video tape rental stores.

My wife, Debbie, and I, have two grown children. Our daughter Sarah and her husband Garrett live in Indiana and have three boys. Our son, Michael and his wife Molly live in Missouri, and have two daughters.

Having grown up in poverty, I have a heart for ministry in serving those with financial challenges. In Jacksonville, I was instrumental in developing the Unmet Needs Program, which was modeled after a similar church led group in Quincy, IL. My desire is to bring more churches of Cass County into the Intra Agency program for better communication and understanding to help push back against the social problems that many people find themselves facing on a daily basis. I would also like to develop educational opportunities that lift people out of the cycle of dependency. Another dream is to establish a local heating and cooling center or temporary overnight shelter for those in worst case scenarios.
